AB 2691

Crimes:
Sexual

AB 2551

Crimes:
Elder Abuse

Changes definition of "elder"
from 65 to 60 years old
expanding inclusion of more
people for benefits and
resources.

Labor Rights Cont.

Seeks Permanent funds for outreach and community engagement work through non-profits and other groups.

SB 1030

CWOP: California Workplace Outreach Project

Ensures housing for farmworkers and their families preventing separation because of outdated policies. children's education is not interrupted.

SB 2240

Farm labor centers: migratory agricultural workers

Women's Health

SB 1016

Latino & Indigenous Disparities Reduction Act

Requires state departments to collect and disaggregate data for indigenous Mesoamerican and Latino population groups in California

AB 3149

Promotores Advisory and Oversight Workgroup

Establishes this workgroup led by Promotoras, under the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to advise DHCS on the implementation of the CHW/P/R Benefit under the Medi-Cal program.

Environmental Justice / Sustainable Agriculture

AB 408

Climate Resilient Bonds

Proposes investments to create a healthier, equitable, and climate-resilient food and farming system with 50% of the bonds going to farmers, ranchers, and communities of color.

SB 583

Salton Sea Conservancy

Authorize the Salton Sea Authority to support infrastructure financing districts for purposes of restoring the Salton Sea.
